### **Advice to Parents – Years 7, 8, 9 and 10**

Dear Parents of children in Years 7, 8, 9 and 10

We have been made aware of two staff members and a year 11 student who have tested positive for COVID 19 over the weekend.

We know that you may find this concerning but we are continuing to monitor the situation and are working closely with Public Health England. This letter is to inform you of the current situation and provide advice on how to support your child. Please be reassured that for most people, coronavirus (COVID-19) will be a mild illness.

The two staff members and Year 11 student are now isolating and we wish them all well. As a consequence, all Year 11 students have separately been informed that they must now isolate and stay at home for 14 days. Their family members do not need to isolate unless anyone in the household show symptoms.

In addition, I took the decision to close school for one day to allow a full deep clean. This was a precautionary measure only and additional to guidance provided. I do not take the closure of school lightly and thank you for your support.

In line with DfE guidance and assuming no further notifications of any cases are received, the school will be open to Years 7, 8, 9 and 10 from tomorrow, Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> November and your child should continue to attend as normal if they remain well.

### **What to do if your child develops symptoms of COVID 19**

If your child develops symptoms of COVID-19, they must not come to school and should remain at home for at least 10 days from the date when their symptoms appeared. Anyone with symptoms will be eligible for testing and this can be arranged via <https://www.nhs.uk/ask-for-a-coronavirus-test> or by calling 119.

All other household members who remain well, must stay at home and not leave the house for 14 days. This includes anyone in your 'Support Bubble'.

The 14-day period starts from the day when the first person in the house became ill.

Household members should not go to work, school or public areas and exercise should be taken within the home.

If you require help with buying groceries, other shopping or picking up medication, or walking a dog, you should ask friends or family. Alternatively, you can order your shopping online and medication by phone or online.

Household members staying at home for 14 days will greatly reduce the overall amount of infection the household could pass on to others in the community

If you are able, move any vulnerable individuals (such as the elderly and those with underlying health conditions) out of your home, to stay with friends or family for the duration of the home isolation period.

## Symptoms

The most common symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are recent onset of:

- a new continuous cough
- a high temperature
- a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

**For most people, coronavirus (COVID-19) will be a mild illness.**

## How to stop COVID-19 spreading

There are things you can do to help reduce the risk of you and anyone you live with getting ill with COVID-19

*Do*

- wash your hands with soap and water often – do this for at least 20 seconds
- use hand sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available
- wash your hands as soon as you get home
