Uniform:

Detailed information regarding our Academy uniform can be found on the school website. For ease of information, please find an overview of the uniform expectations below. Please be reminded that students not wearing the correct uniform will be loaned the relevant item(s) in support.

- **Black tailored trousers -** no leggings or jeans.
- A plain **black belt** is recommended but not compulsory.
- Jewellery may include two plain stud earrings and a watch - no other piercings are allowed.
- No false nails and no false eyelashes.
- Natural coloured hair only and no patterns or shaved heads.
- **School bag** with equipment
- PE kit of Da Vinci top, Da Vinci shorts and Da Vinci hoodie with plain dark blue or black joggers. Cycling shorts and leggings are not permitted.

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Mobile Phones

We wish to inform all parents and carers that, from September 2023, mobile phones are banned on the Academy site for both students and visitors. This means that phones must be switched off and away before walking through the school gates. It is vital not only for safeguarding purposes, but also for the purpose of aiding the focus of students during the school day, that this rule is upheld at all times, and we thank you in advance for your support with this.

We recognise that parents may wish their child to have access to their phone whilst travelling to and from school. If this is the case, students are required to turn them off, and to have them in their bags throughout the school day. If a student does decide to bring a phone to school, this is done at their own risk, and unfortunately the Academy cannot take responsibility for damaged, broken or stolen phones.

Please note that, if a phone is seen, used or goes off during the day, then it will be confiscated and kept safely locked away in the school office until the end of the day (you will be notified by text message).
